Lateral thinking

Edward de Bono introduced the term "lateral thinking" in his 1967 book The Use of Lateral Thinking. De Bono, who died in June this year, was a Maltese physician, psychologist and author of more than 60 books.

De Bono wanted to replace traditional methods of problem-solving with an alternative method, whereby all <u>assumptions</u> are challenged and people think more creatively. He also believed strongly that thinking methods should be taught in schools.



Creative thinking was around long before de Bono popularized the concept. For example, in the early 20th century, all shops had assistants who served the customer at a <u>counter</u>. In the 1920s, American businessman Michael Cullen thought "laterally" and let the customers help themselves to goods, inventing the concept of the supermarket.

An expression connected to lateral thinking is "think outside the box", meaning "to solve problems in clever, innovative and original ways".
